The problem

Law is a human social phenomenon, influenced by cultural, environmental, demographic and geographical differences. It therefore adapts to changes occurring in society. It exists in order to socially organize human behavior within it. The numerous laws and their amendments are the proof of the legislator's desire to be in line with the economic, technological, political, cultural or moral developments.

At the end of the last century, the emergence of media and communication technologies caused a revolution that had a profound impact on all areas of life. The Internet has also accelerated the spread and development of information processing and analysis techniques through successive generations. Thus, tremendous potential data was achieved through this computer tool, whether in our personal, professional or scientific laws. The transition from the third to the fourth multi-technical industrial revolution has been through artificial intelligence technologies and their operating mechanisms, algorithms and software, which have enabled reflection and analysis of the data being collected and stored to make appropriate decisions without human intervention.

This reality has resulted in the emergence of new connections between humans and machines, facilitated by the use of interconnected devices or what is known as the Internet of Things.

Automation and artificial intelligence have also reduced routine workloads and helped in achieving greater profitability of economic projects and their digitization in order to create a green economy. Their scope has expanded in several areas: Health, education, security, justice and even in everyday life.

As artificial intelligence approaches human intelligence, this concept raises many questions and problems that must be studied and explored to find solutions.

To link artificial intelligence to law is to link a mathematical equation to the content of a legal rule with a different philosophy and values depending on the circumstances that created it. On the one hand, artificial intelligence is created, programmed and developed by humans to make life easier. Its effects have gone beyond engineering and mathematics, to include the legal field, especially when a programmed machine can think, make decisions, and draw conclusions.

On the other hand, the specificity of artificial intelligence will transform law from a philosophical concept to a technical concept. This leads us to a legal problem: **How can the established legal rules regulating life in the real world organize behaviors and actions in a virtual world controlled by artificial intelligence? Also, how can we ensure reconciliation between the social organization, guaranteeing security and legal stability to promote and protect innovation and technological development?**

Axes of the symposium:

First axis: Artificial intelligence, a new legal concept.

1. **Artificial intelligence, philosophy, and foundations:**
 - The legal nature of artificial intelligence.
 - The scientific definition of Artificial Intelligence.
 - The philosophical foundation of artificial intelligence.
2. **Artificial intelligence, reality, and hypotheses:**
 - Personality theory, contract theory (artificial intelligence as a party or subject to a contract) and its applications (civil, commercial, administrative contracts), liability theories (contractual or criminal).
3. **Artificial Intelligence, Renewal and Innovation:**
 - Moral rights, Industrial rights, Commercial rights.
4. **Artificial intelligence, protection, and overcoming:**
 - Human dignity, civil and political rights, social and economic rights.

Second axis: Artificial intelligence, a new challenge for Law

1. **Artificial intelligence and the creation of law:**
 - Technological variables and the creation of the law (formulation method, legal engineering)
 - Economic variables and the creation of law, Meta to, and law.
2. **Artificial intelligence and legal services:**
 - Artificial Intelligence and legal and social justice, artificial intelligence and procedural rules (civil, administrative, criminal...),
 - Artificial intelligence and dispute resolution (predictive justice, alternative methods...), the public sector in the face of the challenge of artificial intelligence.
3. **Artificial intelligence and legal confrontation:**
 - New crimes related to artificial intelligence (privacy and financial issues, individuals, nationality, and border crossing), Intelligence between ethics and governance (legislative approaches and models), artificial intelligence and accountability.
