The LEADS project.

LEADS (Linguistic, Entrepreneurial And Digital Skills) is a project funded by the European Union within the Erasmus+ program. With a duration of three years (December 2023 - December 2026), it brings together a consortium of 10 partners from 5 countries: Algeria, Italy, Latvia, Norway, and Türkiye.

The objectives of the LEADS project are as follows:

- To develop a reference framework for linguistic, entrepreneurial, and digital skills for Algerian higher education.
- To implement training and pedagogical tools for teaching these skills.
- To develop placement and certification tests for the three skills.

Results of the First Six Months

During the first six months of the project, the partners have made the following progress:

- **Project website development:** The LEADS project website is now online and accessible at <u>https://www.univ-mosta.dz/leads-project/</u>. It provides information about the project, its objectives, its partners, and its activities.
- **State of the art:** A literature review has been conducted in the three areas of expertise of the project: linguistics, entrepreneurship, and digital. This review has identified the key skills to be developed among Algerian students and has reviewed best practices in training in these areas.
